Kaihāpai Mate Pukupuku | Māori Cancer Care Coordinator

Dannevirke, Manawatu Full Time 40Hrs

The Kaihāpai will support whānau throughout the cancer journey, from pre-diagnosis to ongoing care. This service includes providing advocacy, service coordination, and health education to ensure whānau receive the support they request. Additionally, the Kaihāpai will contribute to cancer-related services across the cancer control continuum, promoting early detection, treatment, rehabilitation, and palliative care.

The Kaihāpai will facilitate improved access for Māori to cancer services, improve the level of communication and facilitate increased knowledge and information about the illness, support Māori community development intitiatives for cancer, record and report data, develop programmes and whānau care plans which incorporate tangata whenua models of care e.g. Te Whare Tapa Wha, Te Wheke and Tawakeroa – Rangitāne health strategy.

If you have a strong passion and deep motivation to support the wellbeing of Rangitane whanau, hapu and iwi, high work standards, proven relationship management, ability to work independently and as part of a team, ability to empathise with whanau, pride in your personal appearance and presentation and have the ability to work with a range of cultures is an obvious must for this role.

Relationships are at the heart of our mahi allowing us to work together as one (Kotahitanga). Understanding Rangitānetanga, Te reo me ōna Tikanga is important to our kaupapa. If you are not confident in your knowledge and skills in these areas, we encourage you to discuss this with us anyway. What is essential is an acceptance, respectfulness, and willingness to grow your knowledge and understanding as part of our organisation.
